

# **Eleventh Congress of the republic of Texas**

## **At the first Session**

*Begun and held at the town Washington-on-the-Brazos on Saturday,  
the ninth day of September, Two Thousand Six A.D.*

### **An Act**

To amend the act entitled an act adopting a National Seal and Standard for the Republic of Texas, approved the 10<sup>th</sup> of December 1836;

To amend the act entitled an act amending an act entitled an act adopting a National Seal and Standard for the Republic of Texas, approved 25<sup>th</sup> January 1839.

*Be it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the republic of Texas in congress assembled:*

*Sec.1 Known as Senate Bill No. 2006-09-0001 and H.R. Bill No. 9-09-1-2006.*

*Sec.2 Be it further enacted, from and after passage of this Bill, the national great seal of the republic of Texas shall be, and the same is hereby declared to be a single star of five points with the letters "Republic of Texas" arranged along a balanced arc concentric to the bottom and outside the circumscribing circle formed by the star points, with a larger second circumscribing circle enclosing the letters "Republic of Texas" between the two circles. One point of the star shall point straight up toward the top of the seal, whereby the lettering on the seal shall be in a balanced position at the bottom of the seal; anything in the act to which this is an amendment to the contrary notwithstanding.*

*Sec.3 Be it further enacted, from and after passage of this act, the previous great seal for the republic of Texas is declared obsolete and an historical artifact. Said great seal for the republic of Texas must be preserved as part of the permanent records in the Texas Archives.*
