**NOTICE with DEMANDS**

From: the president pro-tem of the de jure republic of Texas, representing the people within the geographical jurisdiction of the republic of Texas, under the organic 1836 Constitution as amended in the year of our Lord two thousand six.

For: Treaty Party, the de jure united States of America;  
Attention: President George Walker Bush, hereinafter "you and your entirety" and for PRESIDENT GEORGE W. BUSH of the CORPORATE UNITED STATES including it's entire derivatives relating or referencing with the same intent.

Dear Mr. President:

The president pro-tem of the de jure republic of Texas herein sets forth; the nineteenth day in the month of November the year of our Lord two thousand and eight.

**NOTICE with DEMANDS** for you and your entirety, including but not limited to entire said heads of states and individuals who knowingly and unknowingly are now purportedly public persons and agents representing unauthorized foreign interest on the lands within the de jure venue and geographical jurisdiction of the republic of Texas.

**NOTICE**

The de jure government of the united States of America is without authority of a Treaty of Annexation being attained by proper negotiations, legislation, regulation and delegated approval with the de jure republic of Texas sovereign Nation; and; there being no existing lawful authority for annexing a de jure sovereign nation on this planet by way of a so-called resolution, you are considered unlawfully trespassing on our lands, waterways and airways without a lawful International Treaty of Peace; and, this time frame has existed on or about 164 years *ab initio* 1845.

Furthermore, your acting UNITED STATES CORPORATISM GOVERNMENT and its entirety is doing business as and is using laws of color within the republic of Texas jurisdictions without lawful legislated corporate charter authority and is standing without a Treaty of Commerce giving such authority.

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**DEMANDS**

Therefore, for the security and domestic tranquility of our Texas republic it is demanded that within thirty days from the date of receipt of this dispatch you, or your assigned diplomatic team, must contact and start initiating peaceful negotiations concerning the matters of your continued trespass on republic of Texas lands and your non-chartered corporate prisons holding our Texian people in bondage as commercial properties.

Be it resolved that the joint resolution dated June 26, 1845, attached herewith and incorporated in its entirety herein by reference is hereby repealed and the joint resolution approved by the twelfth congress of the republic of Texas dated July twelfth in the year of our Lord two thousand and eight is in effect.

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## JOINT RESOLUTION

Relative to the introduction of United States troops into Texas and for other purposes.

Whereas, the Government of the United States having passed Resolutions by which Texas may be annexed and incorporated into the American Union; And, whereas, the people of Texas have in their primary capacity, with a unanimity unexampled in the history of the world, expressed their desire and willingness to accept said terms, and have elected delegates to meet in Convention for the purpose of forming a republican State Constitution in accordance with that of the United States; And, whereas, there are many tribes of Indians, belonging to the United States of America, located within and adjacent to the territory of Texas; Therefore, for the security and tranquility of our frontier,

Section 1. Be it resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Republic of Texas in Congress assembled, That it shall be the duty of the Executive of this Republic to invite the Executive of the United States, through their representative near this government, to occupy without delay the frontier of this Republic with such troops as may be necessary for its defence.

Sec. 2. Be it further resolved, That the President be, and he is hereby, authorized and required to call into service the militia, or a sufficient volunteer force of Texas, or so much thereof as he may deem expedient, (in addition to the forces already in service) in case it may be necessary to repel any Mexican troops that may invade, or that may hereafter attempt to invade the territory of the Republic, as defined by our statute.

Sec. 3. Be it further resolved, That this joint resolution take effect from its passage.
