

BILL TO RETURN PROPERTIES TAKEN FROM TEXIANS

Be it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the republic of Texas, in Congress assembled.

Bill proposed by the senate of the Fifteenth congress of the republic of Texas on the eighteenth day of September, Two Thousand and Ten.

After the people's congressional senate and house of representatives for the republic of Texas, in a meeting of congress assembled, under the rules of necessity, the following Act was created by the bill numbers as approved and adopted.

Senate bill Number 1009-1802

House bill number 09-20-01-2010

A bill to return lands that were confiscated for taxes, by the CORPORATIST several STATES AND COUNTY GOVERNMENTS to the lawfully adjudicated owners or the heirs or assigns.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the senate and house of representatives of the republic of Texas in Congress assembled, that the corporatist governments of THE STATE OF TEXAS, THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO, THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA, THE STATE OF COLORADO, THE STATE OF KANSAS, and THE STATE OF WYOMING with it's entire derivatives relinquish all lands that were confiscated and sold for taxes in the several COUNTIES of the said STATES above ab initio.

Section 2. Be it further enacted that THE STATE OF TEXAS with its entireties in whole and parts of the following STATES, NEW MEXICO with its entireties, OKLAHOMA with its entireties, COLORADO with its entireties, KANSAS with its entireties and WYOMING with its entireties shall be held responsible for reimbursing the lawful owner, heirs or assigns any actual expenses encountered during the process of confiscation of verified properties claimed and relocation expenses incurred during the time period of these procedures.

Section 3. Be it further enacted that the counties of the republic of Texas and the Sheriffs of those counties be reimbursed for the cost of actual

expenses for re-claiming monies paid for said properties confiscated for taxes, or in such cases as appropriate the properties confiscated by the corporatist STATES with each one's entireties listed in Section 2.

Section 4. Be it further enacted, that it shall be the duty of the Sheriffs of the several counties of the republic of Texas, to make returns to the Treasury Departments of their respective counties of all the funds reclaimed for properties heretofore sold for taxes. All returned funds to said Treasuries to be in Gold or Silver.

Section 5. Be it further enacted, that this act take effect and be in force from, and after, its passage.
